(Effective 1 Aug 1983) Failure to complete a course after receiving an “R”(incomplete) will result in an automatic “F” six months from the end of term.

(Effective 1 Aug 1988) Failure to complete a course after receiving an “I” (incomplete) will result in an automatic “F” if the course is not completed by the end of the following term.

(Effective 1 Aug 1989) Failure to complete a course after receiving an “I” (incomplete) will result in a grade “Fn” (Failure for non-completion) if the course is not completed by the end of the following term.

(Effective 1 Aug 1991) Failure to complete a course after receiving an “I” (incomplete) will result in a grade “F” if the course is not completed by the end of the following term.

(Effective 1 Aug 1983) “WTH” grade designation indicates Student Initiated Withdrawal

(Effective 1 Aug 1984) “ADW” grade designations will be computed in the Grade Point Average as an “F”.

(Effective 1 Aug 1988) “ADW” grade designations will be counted as registered hours to determine academic warning and exclusion status, but will not be counted in the Grade Point Average.

(Effective 1 Aug 1992) “ADW” grade designations will be counted as registered hours to determine academic warning and exclusion status, but will not be counted in the Grade Point Average.

(Effective 1 Aug 1991) “Fn” (failure for non-attendance) grade designations will be counted as registered hours to determine academic warning and exclusion status, but will not be counted in the Grade Point Average.
